Course Details

❖ **Application**

Individual and group applicants are both welcome. Tailor-made courses are offered to group applicants of 15 people.

❖ **Dates**

Deadline for application: June 14, 2021

Date of Enrollment: July 7 - 8, 2021

Course duration: July 9 –August 2, 2021 (4 weeks)

❖ **Chinese for zero-base to intermediate level students**

Learning Chinese-using Chinese in everyday situations, introduction to Chinese language basics and China in general.

❖ **Various Chinese cultural activities**

Colorful cultural experience such as watching Chinese Kongfu show, making Chinese cuisine, watching Peking Opera, learning Chinese songs, visiting the observatory and local companies, and city tour are offered.

❖ **Class size**

Small-size class to maintain a high teaching quality

❖ **Course credits**

You could obtain up to 4 Chinese credits (1 Credit= 1.5-2.5ETCS) by attending the Summer School.



Accommodation

❖ Location

On campus SDUW halls of residence for international students is located around the west gate of the University. A walk of 5 minutes will take you to the famous Weihai International Bathing Beach.

❖ Rooms

All rooms are double rooms with private toilet and shower facilities, air-conditioning, TV and Wi-Fi.

❖ Facilities

There is a public kitchen, an inexpensive laundry and several study rooms in the dormitory building. Six dining halls on campus and restaurants around campus serve a wide selection of food for various tastes.

About Shandong University, Weihai

- ❖ Campus of Shandong University, under the direct jurisdiction of the Ministry of Education, is a key comprehensive university with a long history, a variety of disciplines, strong academic strength, and distinctive characteristics, which has great influence both at home and abroad. It is also a member university of the nation's construction plan of world-class universities (Category A).
- ❖ Consists of over 17,000 fulltime regular students, over 1,200 teaching and administrative staff
- ❖ Affiliated with 119 universities and institutions around the world, with over 500 international students
- ❖ Located in Weihai, a city recognized by UN Habitat for its quality of life
- ❖ Surrounded by Majia Mountain, and Weihai International Bathing Beach, and boasts 6 kilometers long coastline



About Weihai

- ❖ A beautiful coastal city in eastern Shandong Province. As the Blue Leisure Centre, as well as one of

the World's Most Livable Cities, Weihai is also the first city awarded China's State-Level Hygiene City. The city boasts a coastline of 985 kilometers, which accounts for 1/18 of China's total length of coastline and is endowed with beautiful and enchanting scenery.

- ❖ Weihai has many famous tourist attractions, such as one of the best bathing beaches of China—Weihai International Bathing Beach, 5A level national scenic spots—Liugong Island and Huaxia Cheng Scenic Area, the biggest and the most unique coastal wildlife park in China—Xixiakou Wildlife Park. Weihai is also the host city for a range of sports events including Weihai International Sailing Race and the China Triathlon, attracting participants from all over the world. Famous for its fine beaches, balmy weather and crystalline waters, Weihai also receives tourists from all around the globe every year.
- ❖ Weihai enjoys convenient domestic and international transportation. The city is only 95 nautical miles west of South Korea, and 174 nautical miles from Japan, making it China's closest area to these two countries. Direct flight to Beijing, Jinan as well as Seoul merely takes around 1 hour. Being part of Shandong peninsula's high-speed rail network, Weihai is also connected to Qingdao and Yantai by 1-hour and to Beijing by 6-hour train ride.



Fees and Expenses

- ❖ Tuition: RMB 3200/Person
- ❖ Campus accommodation: RMB 80/Person/Day
- ❖ Meals: RMB 30-60/Day (on your own expense)

Additional Info

For your stay in China you will need an international health insurance. All participants should purchase their own insurances before the enrollment (please show your insurance policy when register), and the validity of the insurance should cover your stay in Weihai.
